When you start your training you actually go out on the road with qualified paramedics in your 1st year!!!

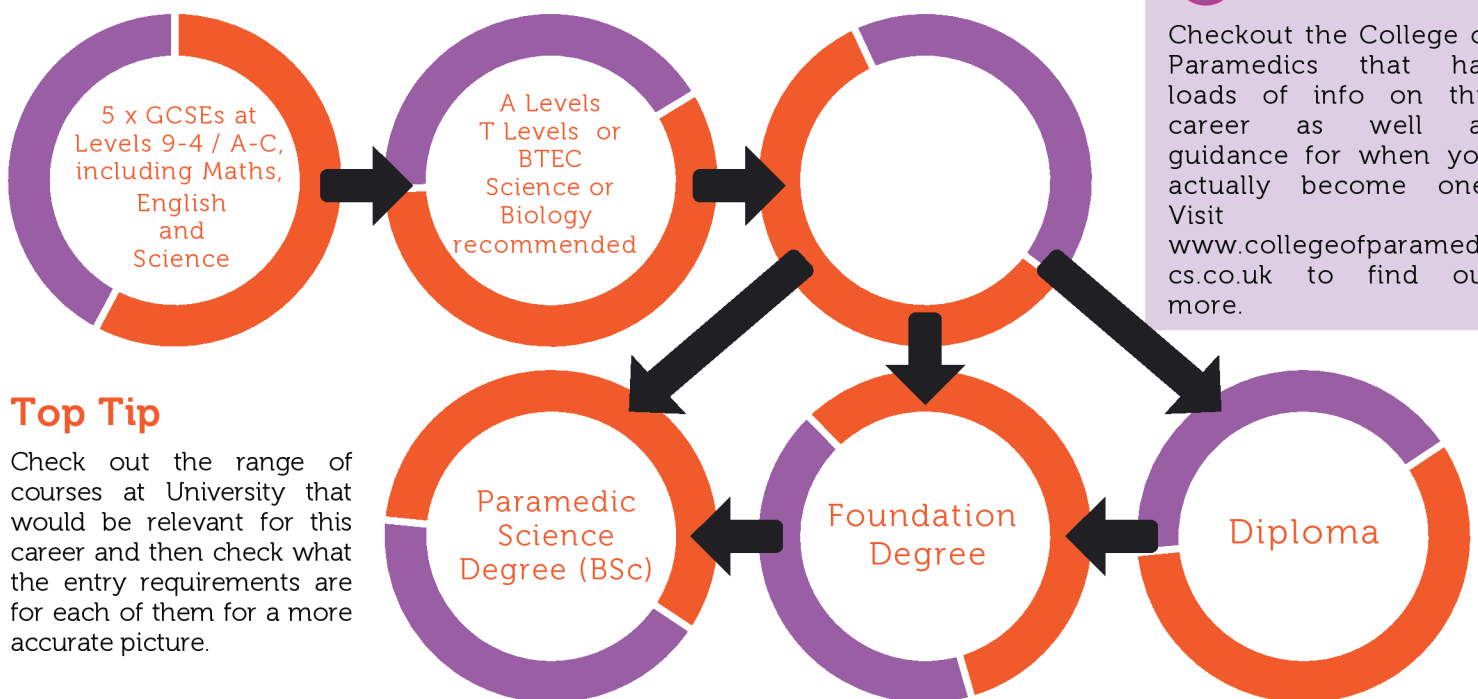
