These guys & gals use techniques including spectrophotometry, mass spectroscopy, high performance chromatography, electrophoresis & immunoassay.

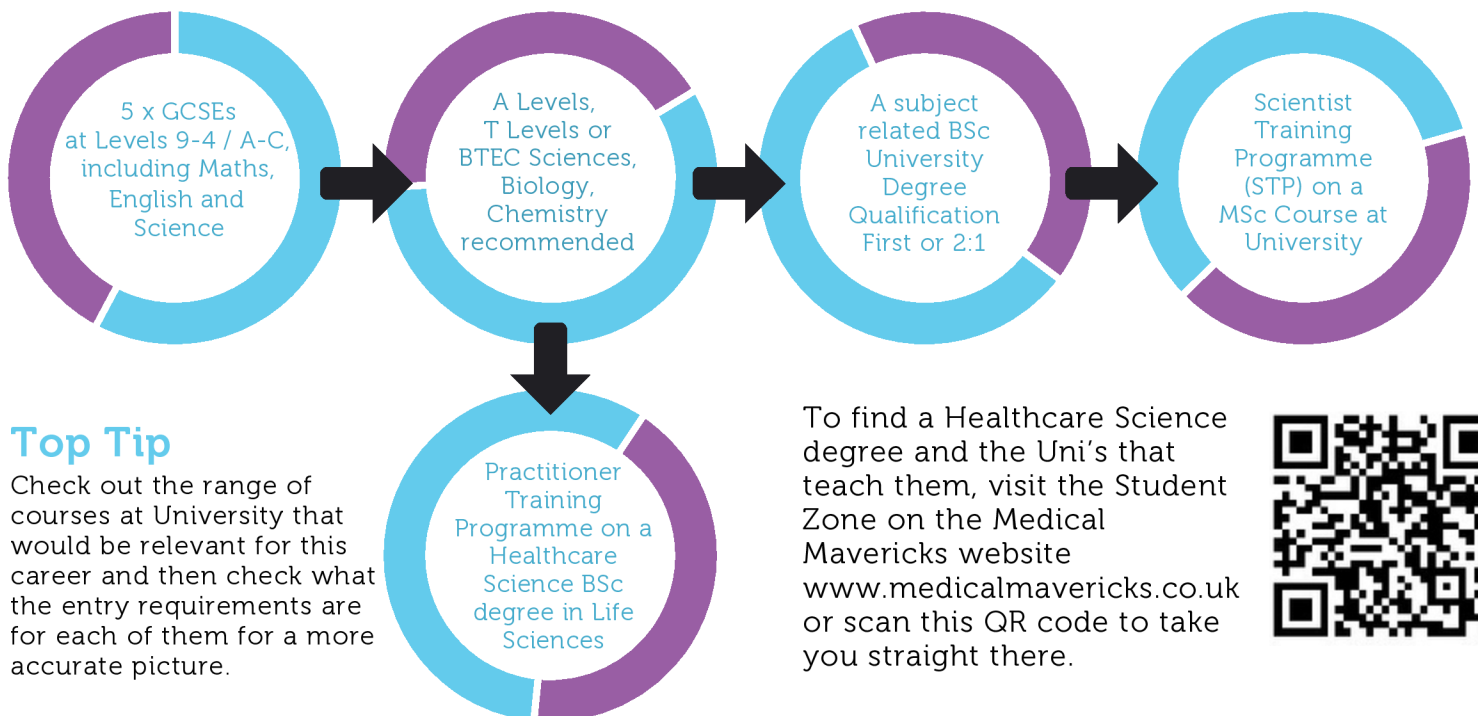

This is a very varied job that encompasses many skills. You will have to be a good communicator with as it the results you produce need to be relayed correctly to other clinicians. You also have some patient contact, which requires empathy and listening skills. You need to be able to write reports as well as be good with numbers.

In addition research can play a massive part of a clinical biochemist work. Without research, we would not have new tests to identify diseases, new or more efficient treatments, making this job vital to patient care.
